

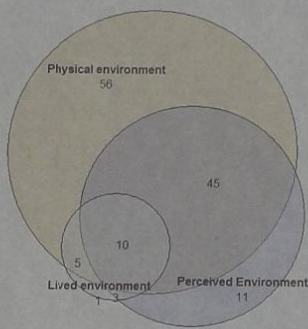
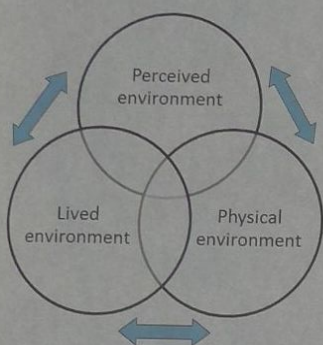

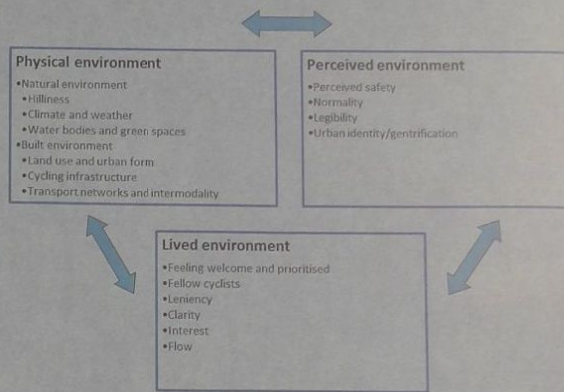
First article: Systematic literature review on **relationship between urban environment and cycling**

136 articles analysed

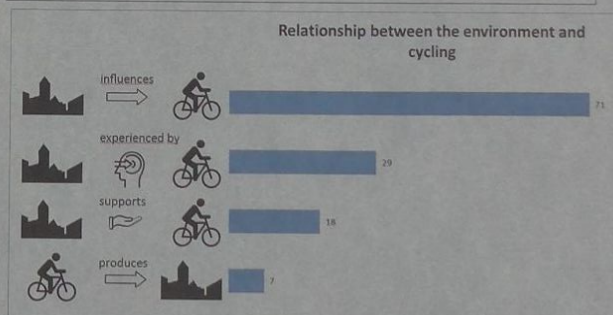
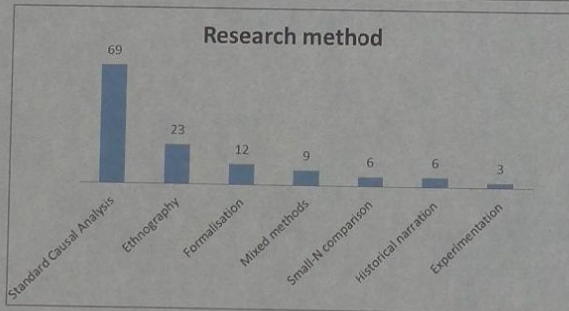
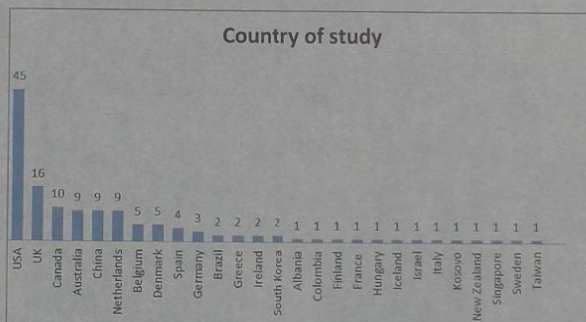
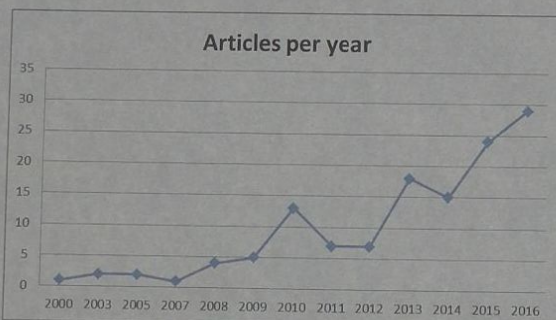
Conceptual framework:



Topic coverage

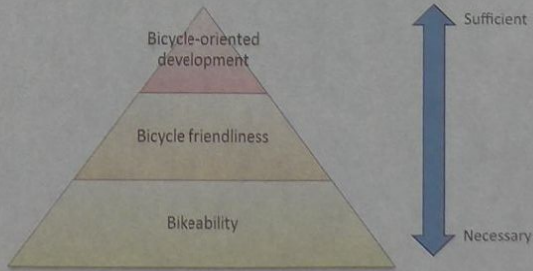


Main themes

- Need to move beyond simplistic understanding of causality between environment and cycling
- Need to explore environmental hierarchy of conditions for cycling
